Monday, 8/3: Belmopan: Visit to Western Regional Hospital, a Community Health Workers Program & the University of Belize Nursing Program, & a residential mental health facility and home visits with a local community health worker (if available)

Tuesday, 8/4: Belize City: Visit with Belize Healthcare Partners, a private urban hospital, an urban public outpatient clinic, a residential home for children, and a public nursing home

Wednesday, 8/5: Conduct day-long public health-style free clinic (tentative)
